APPROVAL CRITERIA

Mozobil (plerixafor injection) may be approved in combination with granulocyte colony stimulating factor (G-CSF) to mobilize autologous hematopoietic stem cells in adults (greater than or equal to 18 years of age) when the following criteria are met:

- I. The individual has a diagnosis of (Hodgkin or non-Hodgkin) lymphoma, multiple myeloma or testicular carcinoma; **AND**
- II. After stem cell mobilization and collection, a subsequent autologous hematopoietic stem cell transplant is anticipated; **AND**
- III. A maximum of up to four consecutive doses of Mozobil (plerixafor) injections per cycle (each cycle is 4 days) for up to 2 cycles per year (maximum of 8 injections per year).

Investigational and may not be approved:

Mozobil (plerixafor injection) is considered **investigational and may not be approved** when the criteria above are not met.

Mozobil (plerixafor injection) is considered **investigational and may not be approved** for all other indications, including but not limited to the following:

- I. As a mobilizing agent for an allogeneic stem cell donor.
- II. As a mobilizer of leukemic cells.
- III. As a component of a conditioning regimen prior to an allogeneic hematopoietic stem cell transplant.
