## Oxbryta (voxelotor)

Override(s)	Approval Duration
Prior Authorization Quantity Limit	1 year

Oxbryta (voxelotor) 500 mg	3 tablets per day

If individual is using Oxbryta (voxelotor) in combination with strong or moderate CYP3A4 inducers (e.g. rifampin) dose may be increased to up to 2,500 mg per day.

### **APPROVAL CRITERIA**

Requests for Oxbryta (voxelotor) may be approved if the following criteria are met:

- I. Individual is 12 years of age or older; **AND**
- II. Individual has a diagnosis of sickle cell disease; **AND**
- III. Prior to initiation of Oxbryta therapy, individual had at least two episodes of sickle cell related pain crises in the past 12 months; **AND**
- IV. If individual continues using in combination with hydroxyurea, the hydroxyurea dose must be stable for at least 3 months.

Requests for Oxbryta (voxelotor) may not be approved when the above criteria are not met and for the following:

- I. Individual is on a chronic transfusion program; **OR**
- II. Individual has severe renal dysfunction defined as  $<30 \text{ mL/min/1.73 m}^2$  or on chronic dialysis.
