APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for Sublocade (buprenorphine extended-release) may be approved if the following criteria are met:

- I. The individual has been diagnosed with moderate to severe opioid dependence (opioid use disorder); **AND**
- II. The individual has initiated treatment with buprenorphine (8-24 mg per day) by sublingual tablet or its transmucosal equivalent, followed by dose adjustment for a minimum of 7 days to clinically optimize symptoms of cravings and withdrawal; **AND**
- III. The individual is clinically stable on buprenorphine by sublingual tablet or its transmucosal equivalent prior to initiation of injectable buprenorphine therapy; **AND**
- IV. The individual is not concurrently receiving other maintenance or supplemental dosing with buprenorphine products; **AND**
- V. Injectable buprenorphine is being used as part of a substance use disorder treatment program to include counseling and psychosocial support.

Requests for Sublocade (buprenorphine extended-release) may **not** be approved for to the following criteria:

- I. For individuals with contraindications to injectable buprenorphine, such as a pre-existing severe or moderate hepatic impairment or history of hypersensitivity to buprenorphine; **OR**
- II. For individuals not enrolled in a substance use disorder treatment program to include counseling and psychosocial support.

This policy does not apply to health plans or member categories that do not have pharmacy benefits, nor does it apply to Medicare. Note that market specific restrictions or transition-of-care benefit limitations may apply.
