APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for Xtandi (enzalutamide) may be approved if the following is met:

- I. Individual has a diagnosis of castration-resistant* prostate cancer (CRPC).

*Castration-resistant refers to disease progression following either surgically or medically induced methods of castration. Medically-induced methods of castration include luteinizing hormone-releasing hormone (LHRH) agonists (such as, leuprolide and goserelin) or LHRH antagonists (such as, degarelix).

Note: Metastatic castration-resistant prostate cancer occurs when cancer metastasizes beyond the prostate and disease progresses despite serum testosterone below castrate levels. Evidence of disease progression must include either increasing serum PSA measurements or documentation of new or enlarging tumors on imaging studies.
