**KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 18086**

**Gene Expression Profiling**

Effective with dates of service on and after May 1, 2018, the following updates will be made to the coverage of gene expression profiling as a technique for managing the treatment of breast cancer.

1. Gene expression profiling will be covered for individuals who meet the criteria noted in [General Bulletin 18047](#).
2. Gene expression profiling will be limited to one test per breast cancer diagnosis.
3. Codes 81520 and 81521 are now covered and add greater specificity for testing.
4. MammaPrint is no longer considered experimental/ investigational but is considered medically necessary when criteria is met. (For criteria, see [General Bulletin 18047](#).)
5. Code 81599 will NOT be covered.
6. Additional male ICD-10 diagnosis codes have been added.
