POA Requirements

Effective with the processing date of April 13, 2018, external cause of injury (ECI) codes (Chapter 20 ICD10-CM) are exempt from present on admission (POA) reporting. Reference Chapter 20 of the International Classification of Diseases, 10th revision, Clinical Modification (ICD-10-CM) publication for a complete list of these ECI diagnosis codes. The POA indicator is still required for Chapter 19 codes (injuries, poisonings, and certain other consequences of external causes) unless exempt.

Note: The effective date of the policy is April 13, 2018. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The **KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log** on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates, once the policy is implemented.
