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**KMAP GENERAL BULLETIN 17137**

## Wheelchair Seating Assessments

Effective with the implementation date of August 1, 2017, and retroactive to dates of service on and after July 1, 2017, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation procedure codes 97542, 97755, and 97760 will be covered as medically necessary for management of wheelchair seating assessments for all Medicaid beneficiaries. Regardless of provider, reimbursement will not exceed \$500 per beneficiary per year for seating assessment services.

Reimbursement for wheelchair seating assessments is limited to the following approved Kansas Medicaid Seating Clinic providers:

- Carney Center Seating Clinic, Wichita, Kansas
- Children's Mercy Hospital Seating Clinic, Kansas City, Missouri
- KU Medical Center Seating Clinic, Kansas City, Kansas

**Note:** The effective date of the policy is August 1, 2017. The implementation of State policy by the KanCare managed care organizations (MCOs) may vary from the date noted in the Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) bulletins. The KanCare Open Claims Resolution Log on the KMAP [Bulletins](#) page documents the MCO system status for policy implementation and any associated reprocessing completion dates.
