Help Ensure Medicare Part D Members Receive a Comprehensive Medication Review

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services require that plans with Medicare Part D benefits offer a Comprehensive Medication Review (CMR) as part of the Medication Therapy Management (MTM) Program. A CMR is offered to members with three or more chronic diseases and who are receiving at least eight maintenance medications. Amerigroup* Community Care utilizes trained pharmacists to contact our qualifying individual and group-sponsored Medicare Part D members. Prescription claims data is reviewed to identify members being treated for three or more chronic diseases from six core chronic conditions. Amerigroup also encourages retail pharmacists to help members complete a Comprehensive Medication Review.

Please ask these members if they have received a letter or postcard inviting them to participate in a Medication Therapy Management program and encourage them to complete the medication review. The interactive consultation is followed by a written medication summary provided to the member. Members are encouraged to bring the summary to their provider appointments to facilitate discussion. The medication review (CMR) will help ensure our members understand their medication regimen, the importance of taking their medications as prescribed and possible interactions. If the member has three or more chronic diseases from the six core chronic conditions (listed below), and is taking multiple prescriptions and is not already participating in a MTM program, please ask the member to contact one of our trained pharmacist at 1-844-866-3730 to complete the medication review.

1. Hepatitis C	2. Chronic Heart Failure (CHF)
3. Diabetes	4. Dyslipidemia
5. Hypertension	6. Respiratory Disease (such as Asthma, Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) or Chronic Lung Disorders)
