

Preventive service procedure codes updated for 2017

Preventive service procedure codes have been updated. Please be sure to file claims with the new codes according to the dates of service applicable.

Abdominal aortic aneurysms

- Effective January 1, 2017, **76706** will replace **G0389** for Abdominal Aortic Aneurysms (AAA)
- **G0389** is used for services furnished prior to January 1, 2017.

New flu vaccines — Medicare preventive benefit – Part B immunizations

- **90674** — Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (cclIV4), derived from cell cultures, subunit, preservative and antibiotic free, 0.5 mL dosage, for intramuscular use
 - This new flu vaccine code can be used for dates of service August 1, 2016, and after.
- **90682** — Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (RIV4), derived from recombinant DNA, hemagglutinin (HA) protein only, preservative and antibiotic free, for intramuscular use
 - This new flu vaccine is not FDA approved yet, which will be denied. Once approved by the FDA, this would be a covered Medicare Part B Immunization.

Smoking and tobacco cessation

- Effective October 1, 2016, **G0436** and **G0436** will no longer be valid; only for services furnished prior to October 1, 2016.
- Effective October 1, 2016, **99406** and **99407** should be used for dates of service on and after October 1, 2016.
