

## **Review high-risk medication reports**

Amerigroup is required to monitor prescriptions activity for high-risk medications as defined by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to improve patient safety.

To ensure providers are aware of any high-risk medications prescribed for our Amerigroup Amerivantage (Medicare Advantage) members, we fax a list of high-risk medication claims to providers each week.

Amerigroup also distributes a monthly report to prescribers detailing the number of members on high-risk medications and the number of high-risk medications prescribed year-to-date. We also contact members who have filled prescriptions for high-risk medications and suggest that they discuss the prescription with their physician and ask if there is a safer alternate drug.

If you receive a high-risk medication fax or report from Amerigroup, please review it and help us support safe medication choices.
