Frequently Asked Questions

If you rendered services to a Florida Medicaid recipient during the Hurricane Irma State of Emergency between the dates September 7, 2017-September 21, 2017, and you do not have a Florida Medicaid ID number, please visit the AHCA website to register for a provisional (temporary) Medicaid ID number.

For reimbursement purposes, the Agency will expedite enrollment for providers that do not have a Florida Medicaid ID on a provisional (temporary) basis after services are rendered.

The process for provisional (temporary) provider enrollment is located at <http://www.mymedicaid-florida.com>.

On the website, under the *Provider Services* dropdown, you will find the necessary forms that must be filled out to obtain your provisional Florida Medicaid ID.
