**ATTENTION: Durable Medical Equipment (DME) Providers**

**EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:**

To ensure that GA Medicaid members have an uninterrupted distribution of medical supplies during the COVID-19 pandemic, the GA Department of Community Health (DCH) is temporarily waiving the signature requirement for the delivery of their supplies until further notice.

In addition, to limit the burden on our provider network during the COVID-19 outbreak, the Department will be extending existing “approved” DME Prior Authorizations (PA) that are set to expire on or before May 1, 2020.

At this time, the 30-day supply allowance for DME supplies will remain as per policy. The Department will continue to actively monitor for any supply disruption challenges that may arise during this time.
