

Writing prescriptions for asthma inhalers and spacers

Asthma inhalers and spacers are being rejected at point of sale for members who attempt to obtain two inhalers, one for school use and one for home use, if the prescription is written incorrectly.

To ensure the member's prescription for inhalers and/or spacers for school and home use are not rejected, please write the prescription in one of two ways:

1. Write on the prescription to dispense one for school use and one for home use.
2. Write two separate prescriptions and designate on each whether for school or home use.
