

Change to reimbursement for targeted case management (T1017) for CHIP members

Summary: Effective immediately, and retroactive to dates of service January 1, 2013, and later, Amerigroup Kansas, Inc. will not reimburse providers for targeted case management (T1017) for members with CHIP/Title XXI coverage. This aligns with Kansas Department of Health and Environment policy, which does not allow T1017 to be billed for CHIP members.

★ **What this means to you:** Amerigroup will begin denying T1017 when billed for CHIP members. Amerigroup reserves the right to recoup any claims paid for these services when provided to a member with CHIP eligibility.

What is the impact of this change?
