Medicaid Electronic Health Records (EHR) Incentive Program Attestation Requirements

<u>Background:</u> Providers planning to attest for program year 2013 need to log in to their Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) accounts to verify accessibility by March 25, 2014. This will allow time to address any accessibility issues prior to the March 31, 2014, attestation deadline.

♦ What this means to you: If you are an eligible professional, you need an active KMAP number to access and attest for the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program.

Need a KMAP fee-for-service provider number?

If you are an eligible professional enrolled with a Medicaid managed care organization (MCO) but do not have a KMAP fee-for-service provider number, complete the request to apply for Medicaid electronic health records (EHR) incentive programs form at https://www.kmap-state-ks.us/Documents/Content/Forms/EHR/Request_EHR.pdf. Once completed, you will receive a secure user name and password to access the KMAP secure website.
