

Ordering, referring, prescribing NPI requirements to Affordable Care Act for specific provider types

Summary of change: Effective with dates of service on and after April 1, 2015, claims billed by specific Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) provider types must have an ordering, referring or prescribing national provider identifier (NPI) listed on the claim.

✦ **What this means to you:** Claims billed by the below KMAP provider types must have an ordering, referring or prescribing NPI listed on the claim. Claims without an ordering, referring or prescribing NPI for these services will be denied.

Affected provider types

- 05 - Home health agency
- 17 - Therapist
- 25 - DME/medical supply dealer
- 24 - Pharmacy
- 28 - Laboratory
- 29 - X-ray clinic
