Subject: AIM® Specialty Health Outpatient Imaging Utilization Manager

Dear Provider:

Amerigroup Community Care is pleased to announce a new outpatient imaging utilization manager. Effective November 1, 2014, MedSolutions, Inc. will no longer conduct medical necessity reviews for imaging procedures. AIM Specialty Health (AIM) will provide certain outpatient imaging utilization management services for our members.

We will continue to process claims and there will be **no changes** to:

- Amerigroup's clinical and coverage guidelines
- The Amerigroup network of providers offering radiology services to our members
- Pre-authorization for outpatient diagnostic radiology services provided at a hospital

The ordering provider is responsible for obtaining prior authorization for the following services:

- Computer tomography (CT/CTA) scans
- Resting Transthoracic Echocardiography (TTE)
- Nuclear cardiology
- Magnetic resonance (MRI/MRA)
- Stress Echocardiography (SE)
- Positron emission tomography (PET) scans
- Echocardiogram (Echo)
- Transesophageal Echocardiography (TEE)

Other procedures may be added to this list at a later date, and we will notify providers accordingly. Imaging and procedures performed as part of inpatient or urgent/emergent care do not require prior authorization. Providers rendering the above services should verify that an authorization number has been obtained in advance. Failure to do so may result in non-payment of claims.

Please note that adherence to the procedures outlined above is required to ensure appropriate claims payments.
