

## Hospice codes to require prior authorization

**Summary:** Effective April 1, 2018, hospice codes will require prior authorization (PA).

### What this means to me

Hospice codes will require PA, and all requests must be reviewed by Amerigroup Washington, Inc. for PA dates of service beginning on or after April 1, 2018.

### What is the impact of this change?

Amerigroup requires PA for hospice codes beginning April 1, 2018. Please refer to the provider self-service tool for detailed authorization requirements. Go to <https://providers.amerigroup.com/WA>. Under *Provider Resources & Documents*, select ***Precertification Request Form***.

Noncompliance with the new requirements may result in denied claims. PA requirements will be added to the following codes:

- Q5001 — Hospice or home health care provided in patient's home/residence
- Q5002 — Hospice or home health care provided in assisted living facility
- Q5003 — Hospice care provided in nursing long-term care facility or nonskilled
- Q5004 — Hospice care provided in skilled nursing facility
- Q5005 — Hospice care provided in inpatient hospital
- Q5006 — Hospice care provided in inpatient hospice facility
- Q5007 — Hospice care provided in long-term care facility
- Q5008 — Hospice care provided in inpatient psychiatric facility
- Q5009 — Hospice or home health care provided in place not otherwise specified
- Q5010 — Hospice home care provided in a hospice facility
